RESULTS OF MAY/JUNE 2010 CIE EXAMINATIONS

A total of sixty-four (64) candidates from EAIS sat for the Cambridge International Examinations at Key Stages Two and Three, in May/June 2010. The results were as follows:

12 out of the 19 students achieved the high possible grade of (C). This represents 63%. On the whole, 18 out of 19 students passed the exam meeting CIE's expectation.

This represents 95%. One (1) student had G.
